

## Class Selector

To help you to decide which class to join:

### General class with Antoine and Ken

This class is for people who are familiar with all the steps and common formations and understand the concepts of covering, phrasing and good handling. You should be able to sustain the energy level for the duration of the class.

### Advanced class with Antoine and Ken

This class is for dancers who can execute the steps and formations to a good standard, and dance with good covering, handling and phrasing. Dancers must also be able to assimilate instructions quickly and be able to sustain a high energy level for the duration of the class.

### Improvers with Anne and Calum

This class is for people who have been dancing *regularly* for at least a year and have an elementary knowledge of steps and basic formations. Attention will be given to improving dancing and introducing more difficult formations, covering, phrasing and good handling.

### Beginners with John

This class is for people new to Scottish country dancing. Attention will be given to the steps and basic formations.

*The 'Putting on a Demonstration' class is for advanced dancers only. Numbers will be limited according to the request of the teacher and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. It is free to attend if you are attending the Day School and/or Evening Dance. **Antoine & Ken***

The session of **Ceilidh & Sequence** dancing is free to attend if you are attending the Day School and/or Evening Dance. This session will be taken by **Catherine Smith, Chris Brown and Penny Bysse, with Calum.**
